### PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Aspiring Artists is a non-district sponsored enrichment initiative designed to elevate visual arts education for high school students. This exciting opportunity aims to enhance artistic skills beyond the classroom setting, providing an immersive and comprehensive experience for young artists.

The Aspiring Artists program is intended for high school students who are passionate about the visual arts and seek to deepen their knowledge and skills in a supportive, professional environment.

## BENEFITS

By completing the Aspiring Artists program, participants will:

- Acquire essential skills and knowledge to thrive in the dynamic field of visual arts.
- Build valuable connections within the arts community.
- Gain professional experience through the group exhibition, learning how to present and sell their artwork.



### **CURRICULUM & ACTIVITIES**

Over the course of five months, participants will engage in a variety of enriching activities, including:

- **Skill-Based Workshops:** Topics include crafting an artist statement, and marketing yourself and your artwork
- **Field Trips**: Visits to local art institutions and art fairs to gain inspiration and insight.
- Group Exhibition: The program culminates in a selfcoordinated exhibition, offering students the opportunity to display and sell their artwork in a commercial gallery. The Opening Reception for this exhibition is scheduled for Thursday, April 17th, with the last day to view the show on Monday, May 12th.
